

Job vacancy – doctoral fellow (slot 6)

The Colentina Neurology Teaching Department at the “Carol Davila” University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Bucharest, Romania, recruits by competition a doctoral fellow within the research team of the project “**Genomic profiling of adult-onset isolated focal dystonia in a group of Romanian patients (GENDYS)**”, PN-III-P4-ID-PCE-2016-0696, led by Professor Bogdan Ovidiu Popescu, MD, PhD. The employment period is from March 2018 to December 2019, and consists of 32 working hours per week. The doctoral fellow is expected to take part to the genetic evaluation performed within the clinical study, as well as in other activities related to the project.

Please submit your application between the 12th of February 2018 and the 19th of February 2018.

The competition will take place between the 20th of February 2018 and the 22nd of February 2018.

The results of the competition will be announced on the 22nd of February 2018.

The candidates may submit any complaints regarding the competition / file for appeal between the 23rd of February 2018 and the 28th of February 2018.

The reevaluation of the candidates that filed for appeal will take place between the 1st of March 2018 and the 5th of March 2018.

Mandatory requirements for the candidates:

- Doctoral student in the field of medicine
- Bachelor's / License Diploma in General Medicine
- Research topic of the PhD thesis: dystonia / the genetics of dystonia
- Written agreement of the PhD supervisor

The registration file must contain the following documents:

- Curriculum vitae and list of publications (dated and signed)
- Certificate from the Doctoral School specifying the field, specialty, research theme and the name of the PhD supervisor (original)
- Written agreement of the PhD supervisor (original)

- Marriage certificate or other relevant documents for those who have changed their name (copy)

The registration file will be submitted at the Registry of “Carol Davila” University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Dionisie Lupu Street, no. 37, Bucharest, Monday to Friday, from 9 AM to 14 PM. The competition will consist of the evaluation of the submitted files and an interview for each candidate. Any appeals should be filed with the Registry of “Carol Davila” University of Medicine and Pharmacy, within the same conditions as above.
